GBS International Tour to Singapore and Sri-Lanka

The Students along with the Management and Faculty team, of Global Business School visited Singapore and Sri-Lanka from the 12th of February to the 18th of February, 2017. They undertook a city tour of Singapore on the 13th of February 2017, followed by a visit to the World-Renowned JURONG BIRD PARK and SENTOSA ISLAND on the 14th of February, 2017, where they spent the day at the theme park followed by laser and musical show “Flight of Time” at the Beach in the evening. This was next followed by a visit to the NEWATER processing plant on 15th February, 2017, which was the best highlight of the International tour. A brief on the learning’s from the Industrial visit is detailed below.

Visit to NEWater and learnings at NEWater

As part of the industry visit, GBS visited the world renowned water treatment and water recycle facility in Singapore to study the working model and the exemplary implementation of effective water recycle and treatment facility. It is worth a mention here that Singapore is devoid of any natural water resources except for rain water and that it purchases water from Malaysia for meeting its water requirements. In its quest for self reliance the NEWater plant was commissioned and today it stands as a proud achievement of Singapore, meeting 30% of its drinking water requirements and plans to achieve 50% of the requirements by 2050. Students of GBS had an enriching and a highly interactive and informative study opportunity and analysis of the system. The students studied the various stages of water treatment. The ingenuity of the facility has had a defining impact. Water from every source is treated at the plant and the resultant purified water exceeds WHO standards. The most important learning that GBS wishes to share with the administration and citizens of Hubli Dharwad is that of water conservation, water recycling and a water treatment and processing plant is the need of the hour and one can be commissioned to treat the sewage and used water and the same could be used to fuel the infrastructure growth that we are witnessing today in our twin cities. With the advent of 24/7 Water supply this suggestion is well founded in its value addition form of water usage and conservation and treatment based on the need and requirement. Water conserved today will ensure growth and life for the future generations. The Management Team comprising of Mr. Mahendra Kothari, Mr. Bharat Jain, and Mr. Jitesh Jain along with the Director of GBS Dr. Anilkumar Garag and faculty of GBS, Mr. Veeresh Noolvi, Mr. Ramesh Chadrahasa and Mr. Ganapathi Shet accompanied the students. The students returned to INDIA via Colombo where they undertook a city tour, covering the notable landmarks like Gangarama Temple, Independence Square among other national landmarks, before embarking on their flight back to INDIA.

Mr Vijay Doddwad started his session with few of following questions to the students, “Life is calling where are you?”, “How would you like to live? “, “What are your ambitions?”. There was time when people were afraid to dream to go against the popular belief , but a duo of Vijay Doddawad and his friend Jagdish Govinkoppa dared to look beyond and envision something bigger and started up a coffee bar in Dharwad which they named as BREWBERRY. The idea of opening a coffee bar stuck them when they visited Bellary, and saw a small coffee shop run by mid aged women. She was capable to manage Italian cuisine like pizza, burger, pasta etc. This struck Mr. Vijay with the thought that “why not make the same with our own twist and image”, by this the idea of a coffee bar was conceived.

Blueberry is not your typical coffee shop/ restaurant. The founders believe in ethical profit. Blueberry gives you a fresh perspective of coffee bar which is one with the nature. They have a staff of indigenous but trained rural youth . Mr Vijay Doddwad emphasis that no matter what theory you learn the real world experience is quite different and one that really matters. BREWBERRY'S , have plans to come out with new branches for international customers who are visiting Goa, Hampi and Hospet.

Global Experience Talk Series

Global Business School conducted a session on “STRESS MANAGEMENT.

The session was presented by Mr. Bob Anthony, who has a patent in “Wireless technology”, holds a MBA, is a CPA in USA and works with Adolescence & Welfare Corporation Ltd. The workshop aimed at introducing the students to a new way to manage stress and find out new ways to find solutions to the problem. Dr. Anilkumar Garag, Director GBS college introduced the resource person Mr. Bob.

Mr. Bob’s session started with “how to define a problem?”. A supportive video of Welles Rotary Club was played and statistics was displayed where it showed 11% teenagers suffer from depression and commit suicide.

Then the session had interaction with the students asking suggestion for a problem i.e. what more could be added into a bag pack to make it a perfect bag pack according to us, this was just to make us feel better and reduce the stress of interacting with new people. Further students were introduced to a new concept ‘Divergent thinking’, in simple words it meant a thought process or method used to generate creative ideas by exploring many possible solutions. The last part of session was provided with the students on **PIP (Problems-Ideas-Plans)**, this depicted ‘how to’ find multiple solutions to a problem and discuss them and solve them efficiently in set period of time.

The importance of being PROFESSIONAL

The Session was presented by Ms. Sonu Mehta, auditor and associate consultant at Ernst & Young, Bangalore. The importance of being professional was discussed. The self-evaluation questionnaire used for SWOT analysis and the questionnaires set, proved to be helpful for students to boost the self confidence and gather awareness of the strengths. The situations were demonstrated wherein any one can come to realize their own strengths too. Further the discussion on email ID, and its significance. Why one should not have a funky kind of email ID and how these are viewed in the corporate world and impression in the mind of HR personnel resulting into professional opportunities like job, appraisals, deals and many more. The following session was on " Self Time", that we should give time for self and how important it is to self introspect. To be professional one should learn to say "NO" in the routine personal and corporate life as and when required. "NO is not always negative" Further tips on "train your brain" were shared, for control on the thought process for better lifestyle. The session end with a 30 day challenge of "live for self and not for others", with 30 different instructions for 30 days to have a successful life. In her concluding remarks she asked students to be brave while selecting the company for job , we should never go for monetary benefits only, one must look into "What role I will be ? Will I be happy? , will I be satisfied? Is this my Life for future?"

Session on "Paytm" Digital Payment

The session was presented by Mr. Basil Braganza. Paytm is basically a cashless wallet app with multiple features and uses. It was started by ONE97 Communications in 2010. It's main purpose is to enable people to make cashless transactions for everyday use. Currently the most used method is the credit or debit cards for which a merchant has to face huge expenses and the person who wants to buy a product should carry his/her card. But in the case of paytm the person is good to go with just his/her smart-phone. it enables a person a transaction of up to Rs. 25000/- per month and one can also increase the limit to Rs.50000/- by using a simple KYC (know your customer) step and document verification.

How does it work? - A QR (Quick Read) code is shown on the receivers phone and a scanner is shown on the senders phone. The sender just needs to scan the receivers code and click send. Within a minute the balance is deducted from the senders paytm wallet and is received by the receiver.

Features— One can pay for meals, book airplane tickets, railway tickets, and even cinema tickets , apart from online shopping . Paytm gives you plenty of cash back offers and offers to new users. One can pay their cell phone or broadband bills, recharge phone balance and also look for various offers provided by the respective service providers. There are plenty of other features and other various payment options.

Benefits of Paytm - Enables a person to shop or pay for thing without having to carry his/her wallet. Smartphones are carried by almost everyone and this is the main platform on which Paytm is based on. Anyone can accept or send payments and then later transfer it to the bank if required or use it from the Paytm wallet itself. This also supports the Prime Minister's digital India and Cashless payments movements which is a major innovation. Like most developing or developed nations even India will become a country with cashless transactions.

Workshop on Basic Survey Training- from QuestionPro

Mr. Ashwani conducted a training on online survey basics. The session was on how to create and customize surveys, survey distribution, and how to report the results. In total the features offered by Questionpro were discussed. in the sessions. He also trained the students on How to use Mobile App for collecting field data offline, create custom flow and logic, and integration. The session concluded with the details of SPSS exports, charts & analytics, security and social community respondents.
